## 2009 UFO Superswap

January 1 – 1942- the Federal Govt. ends the sale of all civilian cars and trucks  
2 – 1994- Chrysler introduces the Neon  
3 - 1926- GM introduces the Pontiac, the descendant of the Oakland Motor Car Co. bought by GM in 1909  
4 - 1955- the rollout of the Packard Caribbean which was the 1st Packard to have a V-8 engine and tailfins  
5 – 1924- Walter Chrysler shows his first car, the Chrysler-Maxwell  
6 – 1917- Studebaker unveils its “Gold Car” touring sedan, with over 8,000 parts finished in pure gold and valued at over \$25,000 at the Chicago Auto Show  
7 – 1989- the Dodge Viper prototype is introduced at the N. Amer. International Auto Show  
8 – 1993- the 1st Elvis stamp is issued  
9 – 1493- Christopher Columbus reported that he saw “mermaids” and describes them as “not half as beautiful as they are painted”- probably because he was looking at manatees. (not really car related , but really funny)  
10 – 1996- Albert Klein in California set a record for auto mileage with his Beetle with 1,592,503 miles on it and still running  
11- 1913- the 1st hardtop production car is introduced, the Hudson Model 54  
12 – 1900 – the Detroit Automobile Comp. finishes its 1st commercial vehicle, a delivery van designed by engineer Henry Ford  
13 – 1942- Henry Ford patents a plastic-bodied automobile which was 30 percent lighter than ordinary cars  
14 – 1954- Hudson and Nash-Kelvinator merge to form American Motors Corp.  
15 – 1909- a motorized hearse is used for the 1st time in a Chicago funeral procession  
16 - 1953- the Corvette is introduced at a car show at the New York Waldorf-Astoria Hotel  
17 – 1964- the 1st Porsche Carrera GTS is delivered to a customer in Los Angeles  
18 – 1919- Bentley Motors is founded in London,. It was acquired by Rolls-Royce in 1931.  
19 – 1955- the Cadillac Park Avenue, prototype for the Eldorado Brougham, is introduced at the New York Motorama in the Waldorf-Astoria  
20 – 1946- the 1st Kaiser-Frazer autos were introduced and the Waldorf-Astoria  
21 – 1954- GM introduces the Firebird XP-21 show car, the world’s 1st gas-turbine powered car  
22 – 1950- Preston Tucker is declared innocent of all fraud charges, but it was too late to save the Tucker automobile

23 – 1957 – Wham-O introduces the Frisbee, inspired by students tossing pie tins from the Frisbie Pie Comp. to each other  
24 – 1860- Etienne Lenoir is issued a French patent for the 1st successful internal combustion engine, a 2-stroke converted steam engine that ran on coal gas and tar  
25 - 1905- Arthur MacDonald sets a land speed record of 149.875 mph at Daytona Beach  
26 - 1979- the Dukes of Hazzard debuts, featuring the 69 Charger, the General Lee  
27 – 1976- Laverne and Shirley debuts  
“1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8 Schlemiel! Schlimazel! Hasenpfeffer Incorporated!”  
28 - the prototype of the Rolls-Royce Wraith makes its 1st test run  
29 – 1886- Karl Benz receives a patent for his “Motorwagen”, a 3-wheeled automobile powered by an internal combustion engine

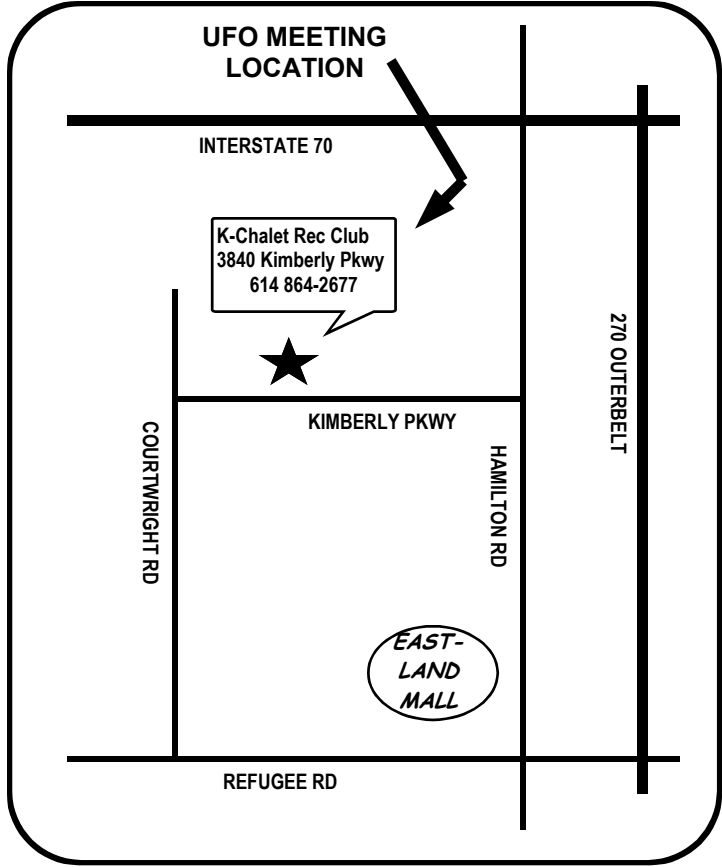
