## Ohio Drive-In Theatres

Here's a list compiled from the Drive-In Movie Association of Ohio's remaining Drive-Ins -- Ohio lost three more this year [Wilmington Drive-In, Skyborn Cruise-In in Fairborn and Melody Drive-In in Springfield -- made it down once to the Melody but never got down to Wilmington [showed two movies for \$5 -- but considering their economy down there ...], so only have Lancaster's Skyview to get to here in Ohio [weather, personal schedule, and movie selection kinda contributes to it, since its a better value to stay for two, although some have triple and quadruple features sometimes, especially around the major holidays so will sit through one to see the others -- sat through the last Halloween movie and most of the folks there didn't like it either and were scarring folks in between the cars, that was over at Winchester Indiana's Airline Twin Drive-In a few years ago, and incidentally it recently closed but re-opened this year under new owners (now the Hummel Drive-In after the new owners name, so it is possible for them to reopen once closed, but already in the hole for the cost of upgrading to digital!)] .

That should be the end of the mass closings for now, Hollywood dictated that by 2015 all theatres, including Drive-Ins, had to convert to Digital format -- easy for the indoor theatres, but with digital projectors, although smaller and more easily to operate [each big reel to reel full length features cost \$1,000 just to ship, compared to the shoe-box size digital print now only \$100 for theatres] the upgrades required the projector needing air conditioning and climate control -- easy inside but for an outside 1949 cinder block that may have expanded to the rear parking lot and adding another screen in future years, the \$70,000 for one screen just doubled to \$140,000 [Wilmington, as mentioned just collecting \$5 and I thought it was going to close and along with Skyborn and Melody Drive-Ins (which I did get to a couple of years back and think wrote an article on) are owned by the Chakeres Theatres chain and with 4 screens needing to switch, yeah. Toyota did have a Save The Drive-In campaign where they would by public vote pay 100% for the upgrades .

## Alternate Fuels

It know this isn't Ford related but I though it interesting .

A new car from Toyota runs on a very renewable resource: human waste. Yes, you read that right: The Toyota Mirai is powered by hydrogen fuel, which can be made from poop.

The process, as Quartz reports, is surprisingly simple. Toyota is using a wastewater processing plant in Fukuoka, Japan, to separate sewage into liquids and solids, and the solid waste is mixed with microorganisms that break it down, creating biogas. After that, carbon dioxide is filtered out, water vapor is added, more CO2 is extracted, and what you're left with is pure hydrogen - a clean, efficient fuel that doesn't emit greenhouse gases.

While this may seem space-aged, it's actually old technology. Marc Melaina of the National Renewable Energy Laboratory told Quartz, "In India, they have loads of biogas plants in villages and such that are just part of their energy infrastructure."

But poo-to-hydrogen technology is not widely available in the U.S. In fact, hydrogen fuel from any source is not widely available. There are only 29 hydrogen fueling stations in the entire country, and most are in California. If you don't live in L.A. or San Francisco, you're shit out of luck - at least for now. But that could change: The U.S. has plenty of crap that could be put to use, especially with the elections going on.


