

## In the Garage—Working on My 73 Mustang

Hi everyone, I have been feeling pretty good lately so I have been back in my garage working on my 1973 Mustang project. My son, Jason and I were able to replace the rear quarter panel on the passenger side and the entire rear panel on the drivers side. We also welded a new tail light panel in along with new floor panels. I fit them and he welded them in, my hand is too shaky anymore. Two winters ago I tried my hand at rebuilding the C6 automatic that I am using in the car. It seams to be working pretty well. I used a "Monster" rebuild kit which was nice because it comes with everything in one box. The C6 is a pretty strong transmission and this company has come up with some improvements to some of the parts to make it even stronger. I had thought about putting in a six speed manual transmission when I first got the car but I have since realized that I am too lazy to do all that shifting by hand. One of the next things that we were able to do was install a "Pypes" performance exhaust. It is a 2 1/2 inch system, which after watching "Engine Masters" I now know that I should have used 3 inch instead. Oh well! But this system does sound really sweet! One other item that we rebuilt last winter was the power steering box, mine was leaking. I got a rebuild kit from Summit, and after several tries we got it fixed. My advice is to buy the rebuilt box instead.

That's it for now, I will let you know what else I get done this fall in a future issue.
